

NORMS FOR AWARD OF DEGREES AND RANKS AT THE CONVOCATION AND GRADUATION DAY:

The following categories of candidates alone are eligible to receive Degree "In Person" at the Convocation.

- 1. (i) All the graduands who have qualified to receive Ph.D. Degrees.
 - (ii) Branch-wise First Rank holders of B.E./B.Tech./B.Arch. (Full Time) degree programmes offered at College of Engineering Guindy, Madras Institute of Technology, Alagappa College of Technology and School of Architecture and Planning.
 - (iii) First Rank holders in each branch of study of B.E./B.Tech./B.Arch. (Full Time) degree Programme from among the non-autonomous affiliated colleges.
- 2. All other candidates shall be awarded degree/diploma in "In Absentia" only on the Graduation Day. After the convocation, the degree certificates for such candidates shall be sent to the Principals of the respective colleges for distribution to the candidates. The colleges shall conduct a Graduation Day and distribute the degree certificates to the awardees.
- First rank holders shall be awarded Degree Certificates, Rank Certificates and the University Gold Medals, one for each branch, in all the Full-Time UG Degree Programmes.
- 4. University ranks shall be determined amongst the candidates who have undergone the full-time UG Degree programmes and who have qualified for the award of degree from the Non-Autonomous Affiliated Colleges of Anna University only, for which, the examinations are conducted directly by the University.
- 5. Autonomous Colleges affiliated to Anna University shall have their own ranking system.
